Observation and Practice Teaching could be completed anytime throughout the course (except during the required onsite weeks) since class meets in the evenings. The dates indicated above are given as suggestions. Observation and teaching practice placements will be made by IFMM once the course has begun, based on each student's preferences in terms of location and availability.
